





SOME INSPIRING EXAMPLES



(from first set of Interviews)

- THE NETHERLANDS: NWO-KIC research funding programme on Safe and sustainable foods and food systems: projects need to cover two or more topics (e.g. Development of healthy and sustainable food products /Food safety, living environment and health...)
- ROMANIA: Resilience research project covering soil, food and health: 5 sub-projects which are all connected through at least 1 partner
- GERMANY: research funding programme BIOECONOMY INNOVATION SPACES: "NewFoodSystems": 59 partners, including 40 companies, 18 universities and research institutions, and one association to explore and develop new food systems as well as production systems for food and feed products

... and more examples on EU level foodpaths

- JPI HDHL & FACCE & OCEANS (ERA-HDHL): SYSTEMIC multidisciplinary project: An integrated approach for sustainable food systems: adaptive and mitigatory strategies to address climate change and malnutrition
- ERA-NETs SUSFOOD2 & CORE ORGANIC: FOOdIVERSE project: multi-level perspectives on transforming local food systems across Europe using a living-lab methodology (how does diversity in diets, novel food supply chains and food governance contribute to more organic and sustainable food systems?)
