Insights first Funders Forum, November 2022 – some highlights



- Co-creation (f.e. through living labs)
- Science combined with (cultural) practice
- Mapping existing knowledge
- Fund not only the "usual suspects" but also vocational and youth/young people
- Multi- and transdisciplinary approaches work accross disciplines and accross food chain
- Fund also comms and dissemination
- More intensive stakeholder collaboration (and also collaborate with industry)
- Consider various impact elements i.e. social, cultural, educational, economic, health
- Support local and regional approaches for scaling
- Clustering and cross-fertilisation
- Defining "what is a healthy food system?"
- Explore more coherent public policy
- Connect to SMEs (not only large corporations) and farmers

What do we need from you?

- Examples (from all scales: regional/national/EU/international) of how Food
 Systems transition can be supported through transnational R&I funding


- Aim: Co-creating the Prototype Horizon Europe Partnership on Sustainable Food Systems for People, Planet and Climate

- 17 partners representing 19 networks










