How can we ensure that all voices are heard and all actors give input?

How can Research and Innovation provide effective solutions?

To tackle these challenges, a comprehensive, long-term strategy designed by different public, private, academic, philanthropic, and non-governmental stakeholders at local, regional, national, European and global levels is paramount.

In this context, the European Commission (EC) promotes the creation of **the European Partnership on Sustainable Food Systems (SFS) for People, Planet & Climate**, to be launched in 2024 (FutureFoodS).

FOODPathS guiding the way

Leading the way in this initiative is FOODPathS: this project has the mission to create a clear pathway, operational framework, and tools for FutureFoodS, ensuring inclusive and sustainable governance aligned with stakeholder expectations and contributions. Through collaboration with a diverse range of food system stakeholders, we are developing a tangible prototype for FutureFoodS.

FOODPathS is co-designing:

1 Future funding mechanisms and strategies that can maximise the impact of Research and Innovation towards SFS by gathering experiences and expertise from the Network of Funders.

4 FOODPathS supported and co-coordinated the Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda (SRIA) for FutureFoodS, and will continue providing input for call topics and next versions of the SRIA.

3 Education and training programs through a network of higher education institutes working in food systems.

2 A Hub of Food Systems Living Labs to overcome current fragmentation and show exemplary SFS cases.

5 The trade-offs and co-benefits by researching cases around the world and exchanging best practices.

6 The concepts for co-creation and definitions that allow FS actors to use a common language for food systems.

7 Guidelines for a Food System Observatory for monitoring the sustainability performance of food systems in each EU member states.
