
FOODPathS' Mirror Group Guidelines

A 5-step 'how to' guide to organise and facilitate Mirror Groups. The full Mirror Group Guidelines give you access to a detailed, step-wise approach, tips and tricks, templates and best practices for organising engaging and relevant Mirror Group activities.

A mirror group:

- Brings together organizations and initiatives that are not directly involved in a partnership but may be impacted by it or have valuable experience to contribute.
- Provides a platform for participants to learn about and reflect on the partnership's work, offering input and recommendations to enhance inclusivity and impact.
- Acts as a bridge between stakeholders and EU partnerships.
- May lead to direct participation in the partnership if no conflict of interest arises.





Mirror Groups Help to:

- Support member state representatives in liaising with national-level actors for European partnerships.
- Engage **organizations and networks** not directly involved in a partnership but impacted by its work.
- Include missing perspectives that are essential for comprehensive decisionmaking.
- **Recognize and reconcile** different organizational backgrounds, interests, and agendas.
- Improve **collaboration** by fostering mutual understanding and cooperation.
- Facilitate the **sharing of ideas**, development of a **common language**, and agreement on approaches for **sustainable food system (SFS) transformation**.
- Communicate insights from various networks (local, regional, national, global) to central organizing structures (e.g., steering committees, advisory boards).
- Help build a broad, well-informed community that supports the partnership or project consortium.
- Ensure **information flows outward** from the partnership to affected organizations, such as **member state ministries**.
- Facilitate multi-level exchanges between actors across local, regional, national, EU-wide, and global scales.
